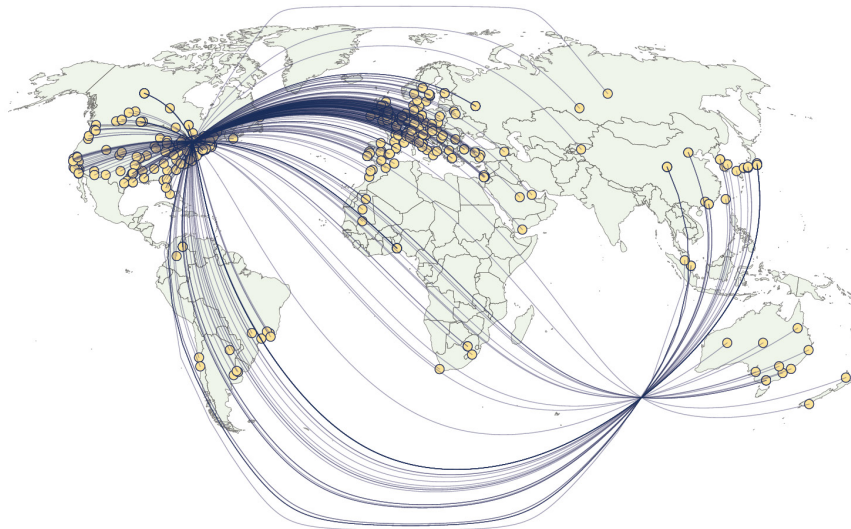
ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO

Established in 1827, the University of Toronto is Canada's largest university, recognized as a global leader in research and teaching.

U of T's distinguished faculty, institutional record of ground breaking scholarship and wealth of innovative academic opportunities continually attract outstanding students and academics from around the world.

With over 90,000 students, 21,000 faculty and staff and 575,000 alumni worldwide; research funding of \$1.2 billion; 700 undergraduate programs, 220 Masters and Doctoral programs, and over 60 professional graduate programs; over 19 million physical and almost 6 million electronic holdings in the library, the University of Toronto's influence is felt in every area of human endeavour.

- U of T is consistently ranked among the top 10 public universities in the world.

World Leading Health Sciences

- U of T and its affiliated hospitals / research institutes form one of the leading health sciences centres for research and education in North America.

Exceptional Researchers

- U of T accounts for only 6% of Canada's professorial faculty, but amasses a dominant share of prestigious Canadian and international honours among Canadian faculty
- #3 in the world for research output

Multidisciplinary Excellence

- U of T is one of only three universities ranked in the top 30 of all eleven fields of the THE subject rankings (2017).

Global Networks

- Over 250 active international agreements and MOUs.
- 19,187 international students from 163 countries.
- 49% publications co-authored with international partners.

Innovation & Entrepreneurship

- Entrepreneurial hubs across 3 campuses assist more than 200 student-led startup teams each year.
- U of T and partner hospitals created 70 new start-ups from 2014-16 and is a North American leader in start-ups based on research innovations and inventions.
