



They are similar to tenured/tenure stream and continuing stream, teaching stream faculty, respectively, in terms of role, workload and ranks. Their workload is prorated to their FTE. They are not eligible for tenure or continuing status.

4. Part-time faculty are reviewed in a 6th year for a continuing appointment, which if successful, results in a contract for a "continuing appointment" which has no end date.

5. Effective October 29, 2020, the new Policy & Procedures on Employment Conditions of Part-time Faculty brought into effect rank changes for faculty at the ranks of Sr. Lecturer and Lecturer. They are now eligible for appointment to the ranks of Assistant Professor, Teaching Stream; Associate Professor, Teaching Stream; Professor, Teaching Stream; Associate Professor or Professor. Note these new ranks should be reserved for those individuals who bear a similar responsibility in terms of teaching, research/scholarship and service, to full-time appointments.







AVERAGE NUMBER OF CONNECTIONS TO WIRELESS PER DAY 2013 to 2019*





AVERAGE NUMBER OF UNIQUE WIRELESS USERS PER DAY 2015 to 2021*








